RATIONALE

A key role of the ETP is to engage with a range of stakeholders pertinent to future communication networks and services. Up to now, these open collaborations have mostly taken place in its Expert Advisory Group and in its SME Working Group

We are aiming extend this engagement to the vertical sectors. This new collaboration area complements and extend the Vertical Task Force activities with the 5G IA.

- 1. Focus on roadmaps, future/long-term requirements, technology and research aspects rather than prototypes products and near-term deployment
- 2. Extend the discussion and engagement globally
- 3. Focus on technology enables and disruptive business transformation aspect towards 2030, including beyond 5G/6G
