The participation of **Azcom Technology** in a couple of 5G PPP projects helped them improve their suite of software IPRs and hardware platforms to build and deploy commercial and special purpose solutions for cellular communications, automotive, aerospace, home automation and mobile applications, both in terms of products and services.

EANTC participates in several European H2020 calls and projects focusing on 5G networks and applications providing benchmarking methodology and state-of-the-art testing expertise. With the innovation cluster 5G BERLIN we established a cluster in the capital Berlin, Germany investigating new 5G technologies and applications for the Smart City, PPDR, and the Industry 4.0 sector. In Q1 2020, EANTC conducted a hybrid remote and on-site multi-vendor interoperability event with more than 100 participants.

The knowledge and innovation gained from the involvement of **eBos** in several 5G PPP such projects were fused into their solutions and services, allowing them to strengthen their expertise in 5G and

Participation of SMEs in the 5G PPP

The main objective was to help reach the 5G PPP KPI of 20% SME participation in the initiative –mostly by raising the visibility of SME skills and expertise



- **The objective has been reached with 20.36% EC funding for SMEs in the 5G PPP**
 - should be around 22% when the latest two calls are accounted for (ICT-41 and ICT-52)
- **183 different SMEs participated in 5G PPP projects** i.e. $\approx 29\%$ of the participants
 - 317 SME participation i.e. 22.3% participation
- 2/3 SMEs participated in one project, 1/3 in two or more projects
- Same level of participation in RIAs and IAs
- High participation of SMEs to the 5G PPP online brokerage platform



SME WG Status & Next Steps



Status

193 members (163 SMEs, 19 research, 10 industry + 5G IA)

- Steadily growing and attracting always more SMEs (+23% members in the past year, +27% SMEs)
- Contributing to more SMEs in NetWorld2020

Next steps

- **Contribute actively to the upcoming SNS Partnership**
 - Promote “SME WG SNS Position Paper” in NetWorld2020 and towards 5G IA and the EC
 - Contribute to the 1st work programme of the SNS Partnership
- **Continue to raise visibility of SMEs and promote their skills and expertise**
 - Next update of the SME web page and brochure shall be released in the coming weeks
 - Engage more with vertical SMEs
- **Strengthen cooperation among SME WG members**
