Election in Research Group (1)



- Members of the respective Stakeholder Group elect the SB representatives of their group
- Due to not having a physical GA, voting was organised electronically from 22/10 – 12/11/20
- 346 Research Stakeholder Group members were invited to vote
- Voting closed on 12/11/20
 - 108 members voted (~31%)
 - The quorum (10%) was reached
