SRIA-process

- The chapter editors formed independent teams
- SRIA editors had a meeting approx. once per month
- Three draft rounds were performed during spring 2020 with a version submitted to public consultation in June.
- The total number of contributors was larger than 150 persons, coming from almost 90 organizations, of which about 60% were from the research domain. We received also two contributions in “aggregated vision format” from two European organizations (NESSI and AloTI) and two external organizations (ITU, CCSA), besides the many contributions reflecting the views of 5G-PPP projects and researchers.
- The final version was published in Networld website in September 2020
